Mr. Stantial,

In reply to your request received on January 26, 2024, we wish to point out that the procurement process that you are referring to is for video lottery terminals owned by Loto-Québec, which are not located in casinos but in a network of retailer operated bars that have obtained a license from the regulator, "Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux".

We can confirm that the procurement process for the acquisition of video lottery terminals was conducted according to the applicable procurement policy, that you can consult [here](#) (in French only). As the result of this process, three suppliers were chosen for the awarded contract: Aristocrat Technologies Canada inc., IGT Canada Solutions ULC and LNW Gaming Canada LTD.

However, the process that was put in place specifically provided confidentiality restrictions, limiting each parties' ability to disclose any information regarding the process and the awarded contract.

Consequently, any additional information that you are requesting is protected by sections 21, 22, 23 and 24 of the *Act respecting Access to documents held by public bodies and the Protection of personal information*.

You may apply for review of this decision before the *Commission d'accès à l'information*. In this regard, please find attached a brief explanation of the rules of procedure before the *Commission*.
